## **Notice of Reorganization of Future Architect Group**

Future Architect, Inc. (hereinafter the “Company”) resolved at its Board of Directors meeting on July 31, 2007 to reorganize the Future Architect Group (hereinafter the “Group”) as described below.

### 1. Purpose of the reorganization

- (1) Following the fact such as withdrawal of partner companies, the Group reviewed the ERP business provided by the former Woodland Corporation group, and decided to scale down the business and shift the strategic target from the small- and midsize-company market to the midsize-company market, as well as integrate consolidated subsidiaries engaged in the business into the Company to effectively use management resources.
- (2) With respect to the operations solutions business provided by the former Woodland Corporation group, centering on sales management systems and ASP accounting systems for small and midsize companies, we will integrate Group firms, which are independently running each operation of the business, into Elm Corporation, our core subsidiary, to concentrate and strengthen our market appeal and sales capabilities.

### 2. Outline of the reorganization
